Mary Catherine Perry is the Director of Policy and Government Affairs at The Policy Project. At The Policy Project, Mary Catherine helped draft, advocate for, and unanimously pass historic legislation as part of The Period Project – a public/private partnership with the Utah Legislature to offer free period products in all of Utah's K-12 public and charter schools. She also played a critical role on the Teen Center Project where she helped secure a \$15 million legislative appropriation to create spaces inside Utah high schools to offer vulnerable and at-risk students access to laundry facilities, showers, and a food pantry. Mary Catherine received a B.A. in English and a Master of Public Administration from Brigham Young University and began her career with the Utah Legislature at the Office of Legislative Research and General Counsel where she worked analyzing policy, conducting research, and drafting legislation.

Mary Catherine has spent 25 years volunteering in public schools and on nonprofit boards dedicated to helping women and children in the community. Mary Catherine and her husband, Jason Perry, reside in Salt Lake City with their four children.
